Student and Staff Notable Learning

Every year, students in Grades 2 - 8 take the Math and Reading Screener (AIMSWeb Assessment). Due to the school being shut down last spring, test results for the end of the 2019-2020 are not available. Posted below are the results from our fall assessment. This assessment data, along with teacher observations / knowledge of students, is used to determine which students receive intensive intervention in math and reading.
