Indicator 14 helps us describe the percent of youth who had IEPs and are no longer in secondary school, and who have been competitively employed, enrolled in some type of postsecondary school, or both, within one year of leaving high school. The post-school outcome surveys are completed.

Part C of our Transfer of Service has been submitted to the DPI. Part C summarizes the requests submitted by our district for new special education or EL costs. All costs were identified as eligible for categorical aid.

We signed a Service Agreement with TeleTeachers to provide a school psychologist for psychological evaluations and behavioral and mental health services. TeleTeachers provide schools with access to certified, high quality services in a virtual environment. It will allow us to complete our evaluations and follow our timelines, while also limiting the individuals who are coming into the building to test our students.
