- 1. Student and Staff Learning:
 - a. ACT scores look good so far. We are still missing three scores, so we don't have an average to share yet, but it is safe to say that we met our goal for this year (20 average composite). We had one student score a 33 on the test which puts him in the 98th PR nationally. That same student maxed the reading test with a 36. We had a different student make an 8 point jump and is now on track for college. Full results will be shared with the board when ready.
 - b. Impactful Coaching- The Association of Wisconsin School Administrators runs a 4 day conference every year to build instructional coaching skills in teachers and administrators. The conference focuses on building productive, impactful conversations between teachers and coaches. It is very well run. Participants leave with a lot of ideas for how to help their peers reflect on their practice and improve. This conference, along with the advanced level, is the basis for the instructional coaching we are implementing at PSD next year. Ms. Hale will take what she has learned from this to help teachers move forward. Other teachers who have been through this (roughly ten in the district) will use their skills as well. We will grow together in 2022-23!

2. Innovation and Recognition:
