1. Student and Staff Learning:

- a. Rod has been meeting with members of the PHS staff individually to get to know them and their perspectives on next steps for PHS. The meetings are informal and semi-structured. So far 11 teachers have met with Rod. Any staff members who are not available for summer meetings will have an opportunity to meet Rod during dedicated time in the inservice days to begin the school year.
- b. Students will have an opportunity to meet with the new principal to start the school year. A community meet-and-greet will be tied to the grand opening of the new CTE building.

2. Innovation and Recognition:

- a. From Mr. Stephen Hadfield: -We received \$16,750.52 from our 2020 CTE
 Incentive Grant. This money will help ensure we meet all the needs of our new
 CTE Facility.
- b. Students earned 206 total dual credits through MSTC for the 2020-21 school year for a total cost savings of \$31,645.90.

3. Looking Ahead:

a. We are preparing to move the CTE classes into the new building and shift learning spaces around within PHS. Ms. Maria Landgraf is exploring creating a high school art room in what has been the family and consumer science rooms near the cafeteria. This will allow the high school students to stay in the building for art.
