Lives in Balance - 15 Week Training

To continue building a school-wide culture to support student behavior in a positive manner that involves the student in decision making, a core group of our staff will be participating in a 15 - week training through Lives in Balance. Lives in Balance focuses on the work of Dr. Ross Greene, whose approach to working with students is to solve problems collaboratively with behaviorally challenging students. Dr. Ross Greene directly supervises the trainer in this program. The staff is aware that a school-wide change is needed and will be happening, in a slow manner as we get all staff trained.

MobileMind - Professional Development for Staff

All district staff (with the exception of a few due to job responsibilities and duties) will participate in MobileMind this year. All staff members are expected to be Level 1 Google Certified Educator by the end of the school year. The program is designed to grow educators' skills in using Google. Each learning path provides instruction and then requires the educator to apply their skills before moving to the next path. All the learning paths prepare the educator to pass the Google exam.

Innovation and Recognition

Healthy Classrooms Foundations Grant

Pittsville Elementary School was a 2021-2022 recipient of a \$1500 grant from Healthy Classrooms. The money will be used to continue our JH Playground Improvement initiative. The Gaga Ball Pit was also funded by this grant. I will be working with the JH students to determine their interests and needs so they have more opportunities to be active during recess.

AAA Traffic Safety Grant

Dan Giles and I applied for a grant to receive \$2500 to help with traffic safety signage for our district.
